SB 397 School-Based Health Centers

Parental Rights Violated as Follows:

Who will be treating your child without your consent?

Section D: School-based health centers shall work in cooperation with schools and school districts and be operated by licensed healthcare providers, including...other qualified healthcare providers (which includes <u>Planned Parenthood</u>).

What services will they provide?

All primary, preventative, and mental health care will be administered through the schools, putting the child's care under government control. The parent would be removed from responsibility for their child's healthcare. This includes all reproductive and gender-affirming care which is now a protected healthcare activity – meaning it's private and shall not be disclosed to the parents.

Section E: School-based health centers shall provide services through licensed providers, including:

- 1. Primary healthcare
- 2. Preventative healthcare
- 3. Treatment of minor, acute, and chronic conditions
- 4. Mental health care
- 5. Substance use disorder assessments.
- 6. Crisis intervention
- 7. Or referrals as necessary for additional treatment, including inpatient care, specialty care, emergency psychiatric care, oral health care, and vision health care services.

What this means:

Your child's health will be in the hands of the government if/when they attend school. This law works hand-in-glove with HB 7 to act without parental awareness or involvement.
